

Dear Mr. Newman:

On behalf of the City of Chicago Office of the Mayor, I am responding to your Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") request received in our offices on April 13, 2012. At this time, I am seeking an extension of five additional working days to respond to the request for one or more of the following reasons identified in 5 ILCS 140/3(e) of FOIA:

- () the requested records are stored in whole or in part at other locations than the office having charge of the requested records;
- () the request requires the collection of a substantial number of specified records;
- () the request is couched in categorical terms and requires an extensive search for the records responsive to it;
- () the requested records have not been located in the course of routine search and additional efforts are being made to locate them;
- () the requested records require examination and evaluation by personnel having the necessary competence and discretion to determine if they are exempt from disclosure under Section 7 of the FOIA or should be revealed only with appropriate deletions;
- (x) the request for records cannot be complied with by the public body within the time limits prescribed by 5 ILCS 140/3(d) without unduly burdening or interfering with the operations of the public body;
- () there is need for consultation, which shall be conducted with all practicable speed, with another public body or among two or more components of a public body having a substantial interest in the determination or in the subject matter of the request.

Dear Mr. Daley:

On behalf of the City of Chicago Office of the Mayor, I am responding to your
Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request received in our office on April 12,
2012. At this time, I am sending an electronic copy of the information requested to you
via email. The information requested is as follows:

() The requested records are being reviewed in order to determine if they
are exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act.

() The request requires the disclosure of a substantial number of records.

() The request is complex in nature and requires an extensive search of
the records maintained by the City of Chicago.

() The requested records have not been located in the course of a search and
therefore, they are being treated as records that do not exist.

() The requested records are being reviewed and evaluated by personnel having
the necessary expertise and discretion to determine if they are exempt from
disclosure under Section 7 of the FOIA or should be provided only with
appropriate redaction.

() The requested records cannot be compiled with the public body, since the
records are being reviewed by the public body, and the records are being
reviewed by the public body.

() That it is not for dissemination, which shall be considered with all records
that are being reviewed by the public body or being reviewed by the public
body having a substantial interest in the dissemination of the subject matter of
the records.
